During the week of April 22-26, 2019, join the National Community Development Association (NCDA) and other stakeholders in celebrating the impact of the CDBG and HOME programs. National Community Development Week is an annual celebration and recognition of CDBG and HOME during the Congressional Easter Recess. NCDA leads the charge on National Community Development Week, but many other national stakeholder organizations also participate, including the National Association of Counties, U.S. Conference of Mayors, Council of State Community Development Agencies, National Association of Regional Councils, National Association for County Community and Economic Development, and National Association of Local Housing Finance Agencies.

- Meeting with your Congressional Member and their staff in their district office to discuss the impact of the programs and the need for more funding.
- Conduct a tour of CDBG and HOME funded projects or invite your Congressional Members and local media to a site visit of one or two projects.
- Host a community event at a project site or ribbon cutting and invite your Congressional delegation and local media.
- Take photos or video of projects and post them to social media, tagging your Congressional delegation. Don't forget to use #CDWeek 2019.
- Write a letter to your Congressional delegation about the impact of CDBG and HOME in the community and the need for more funding. Provide project examples.
- Write a letter to the editor of your local newspaper about the impact of CDBG and HOME in your community.
