The City of Pittsburgh is marking NCDA week with three main activities:

- **Tuesday April 2**, our City Council President will read a proclamation designating the week National Community Development Week, as well as highlighting local nonprofits who have received CDBG funds as part of our Public Service Grant program. Representatives from the organization will attend the reading of the proclamation. The text of the proclamation is attached.
- Wednesday April 3, State and Local elected officials will join Community Development staff on a project tour. Manchester Citizen's Corporation (MCC), a local nonprofit Community Development Corporation, has just started their third year of our four-year-renewable Capacity Building Neighborhood Economic Development Grant. MCC will showcase work they have undertaken to benefit their neighborhood alongside a variety of partners. Congressional Representative Summer Lee will attend, and members of Senator John Fetterman's staff have been invited.
- **Thursday April 4**, the City's Community Development team is inviting Federal elected officials and representatives of surrounding municipalities, as well as the public, to an Open House in Downtown Pittsburgh. This event will allow attendees to learn how various City departments, authorities, and partners use CDBG and HOME funds to improve conditions for our low- and moderate-income residents.
